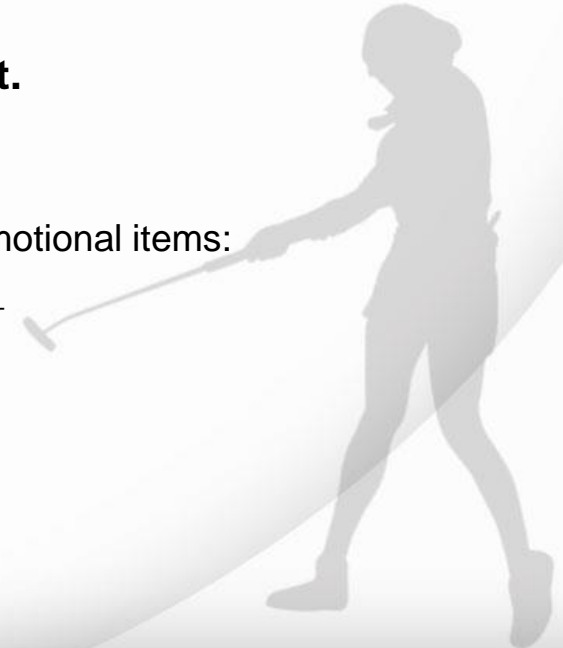

Why should I support ESCADV?

We know that your support is an investment in our mission. We would be honored to have your partnership, and here are just a few reasons why we believe our work offers a great “return on investment”:

- Our service area is both Accomack and Northampton Counties. We are the only domestic and sexual violence service provider on the Eastern Shore of Virginia.
- We offer a 24-hour a day, 7 days a week hotline for people in crisis. We responded to over 150 hotline calls in Fiscal Year 2018. Callers overwhelmingly report that they get the help they need from our hotline services.
- Our survivors consistently report that they received the help they needed and because of the services received, they are more resilient, hopeful, and know how to take their next steps. Survivors stated that because of services received they “have more confidence and are more independent.”

Local contributions are necessary to help us secure grant funding that requires local “match” funding.

- 1 in 3 women and 1 in 4 men have experienced some form of physical violence by an intimate partner. Children who witness violence in their homes are especially at risk. Chances are, someone you know may need our help.

We need your help to continue to provide critical services to our most vulnerable neighbors again this year.
